Screening Questions

1. In the past 5 days have you had any cold or flu symptoms?

2. In the past 2 weeks were you exposed to someone known to have COVID?

If the person answers YES to either question above, ask if s/he has tested negative anytime after symptoms began or at least 5 days after exposure.

COVID Etiquette

In close quarters and small rooms, please apply a mask or remain safely distanced if requested to do so by a person with medical risks for severe disease.

Sanctuary

Orange	Masks required for everyone, including musicians and choir members. Vaccinated speakers and soloists may remove masks when on stage. Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended. Set up 195-215 chairs for a capacity of about 150 (50%). Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household. Limit event duration to 60 minutes with 1 hour between events. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with upper windows partially open. Do NOT turn on overhead fans. Air turbulence can spread the virus.
Yellow	Masks optional but highly recommend for people with medical risks. Vaccinated speakers and singers may remove masks when on stage. Set up all 286 chairs for a capacity of about 200 (75%). Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household. Limit event duration to 90 minutes. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with upper windows partially open.

Green	Masks optional for people with medical risks.
	Set up all 286 chairs for full capacity congregation.
	Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

Reimer Hall

Orange	Masks required for everyone. Maximum capacity of 118 (50%). Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended. No food or drinks permitted. Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with two doors partially open. For groups of <50 people event leader may waive the mask requirement if everyone is vaccinated and screens negative.
Yellow	Masks optional but recommended for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 177 (75%). Personal and pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
Green	Masks optional for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 236 (100%). Food and beverages permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

West Wing

Orange	Masks required for everyone. Maximum capacity of 85 (50%). Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended. No food or drinks permitted. Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household. Limit event duration to 60 minutes. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with two doors partially open. For groups of <50 people event leader may waive the mask requirement if everyone is vaccinated and screens negative.
Yellow	Masks optional but recommended for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 127 (75%). Personal and pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
Green	Masks optional for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 168 (100%). Food and beverages may be served and consumed. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

Seminar Rooms A and B

Orange Maximum capacity of 11 occupants with masks required. Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended. No food or drinks permitted. Limit event duration to 60 minutes. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with door partially open.

- Yellow Masks optional unless requested by person with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 17. Personal and pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
- Green Masks not required unless requested by person with medical risks. Maximum capacity 100%. Food and drinks permitted.

Church Offices and Library

Orange	Masks required for everyone. Maximum of 3 occupants per room and up to 2 visitors total. Maximum capacity of 7 in library. Self screening and hands-free greetings recommended. No food or drinks permitted indoors. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
Yellow	Masks optional unless requested by person with medical risks. Maximum 4 occupants per room and up to 4 visitors total. Maximum capacity of 12 in library. Personal and pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
Green	Masks not required unless requested by person with medical risks. Maximum capacity 100%. Food and drinks permitted. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

Outdoor and Courtyard gatherings

Orange	Masks optional unless requested by person with medical risks. Hands-free greeting recommended. Groups of 100 permitted in courtyard. Drive-through activities and courtyard displays and services permitted. Coffee service, pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted.
Yellow	Masks not required unless requested by person with medical risks. Groups of 150 permitted in courtyard. Coffee service with food and beverages permitted.
Green	No restrictions.

United Tribes and Child Care

Orange Masks required for everyone. Advanced registration of children recommended. Negative screening by parent recommended. Maximum capacity of 11 (50%) in each room. Food and drinks outdoors only, not indoors. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with door or window slightly open.

- Yellow Masks optional but recommended for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity of 17 (75%) in each room. Pre-packaged food and self-contained drinks permitted indoors. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
 Green Masks optional for people with medical risks.
- Green Masks optional for people with medical risks. Maximum capacity 100%. Food and drinks permitted indoors. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

Choir and Instrumental Musicians

Orange	Indoor rehearsals and performances with masks required. Vaccinated soloists may remove masks when on stage. Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with nearby windows partially open.
Yellow	Masks optional unless requested by person with medical risks. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
Green	Masks not required unless requested by person with medical risks. Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.
