COVID Endemic Response Guidelines

SANCTUARY

ORANGE (High risk):

Masks required for everyone, including musicians and choir members. Vaccinated speakers and soloists may remove masks when on stage. Self-screening and hands-free greetings recommended.

Set up 195-215 chairs for a capacity of about 150 (50%).

Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household.

Limit event duration to 60 minutes with 1 hour between events.

Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with upper windows partially open.

Do NOT turn on overhead fans. Air turbulence can spread the virus.

YELLOW (Moderate risk):

Masks optional but highly recommend for people with medical risks. Vaccinated speakers and singers may remove masks when on stage. Set up all 286 chairs for a capacity of about 200 (75%).

Please leave a space or empty chair between each family/household. Limit event duration to 90 minutes.

Turn on fan for continuous ventilation with upper windows partially open.

GREEN (Low risk):

Masks optional for people with medical risks.

Set up all 286 chairs for full capacity congregation.

Turn on fan for continuous ventilation.

COVID Etiquette: In close quarters and small rooms, please apply a mask or remain safely distanced if requested to do so by a person with medical risks for severe disease.

Screening Questions

- 1. In the past 5 days have you had any cold or flu symptoms?
- 2. In the past 2 weeks were you exposed to someone known to have Covid?

If the person answers YES to either question above, ask if s/he has tested negative anytime after symptoms began or at least 5 days after exposure.

If the person answers YES to either question 1 or 2 and has <u>not</u> tested negative at the appropriate interval, then s/he will be invited to:

Return home (and view the service/event online if livestreamed/recorded)

OR

If a test kit is available, the Grusher (or event host) may offer it to the person in question to confirm a negative test result and be allowed entry.
